

#### Coffee Mornings/Afternoon

The easiest way to access support from the Neurodiversity Hub is by attending one
of our coffee sessions to meet the team and discuss the support you require.

accessed via the local offer website.

#### Telephone Advice lin

- If you are unable to access any of our coffee sessions, the Neurodiversity Hub team will be setting up a telephone advice line for parents/carers & professionals which will take place on Tuesdays starting the 13th February 2024
- Please call 0161 206 0606 between 8am and 12pm on a Tuesday morning. You will
  then be added to a 'call back' list and a member of the team will return your call
  between 1pm and 3:30pm Tuesday afternoon. Please note—there will be a set
